## **Newspaper Article**

Write an article for a paper of your choice (e.g. the *Varsity, the Globe and Mail, Toronto Star* or *National Post*) that describes the research you will or might do for your degree, OR gives a review of your field of interest.

The article should be comprehensible to the informed layman. You should convey a sense of excitement and enthusiasm, so that a non-scientist reader understands that the research is important and worth supporting. If you concentrate on a specific area of research, explain its place in the more general scientific field.

**Suggestion**: Copy the style of popular science articles in the local papers or any you can find online – though avoiding the poor grammar or wordiness you may find there! Remember to have a clear beginning, middle, and end! (SET, BODY, CLOSURE)
